

EPICONDYLE

Meaning: Epicondyle: a bony prominence on the surface of a bone, particularly at the elbow, serving as an attachment point for muscles and ligaments.

1. The medial epicondyle of the humerus is an important landmark for several muscle attachments.
2. Injuries to the epicondyle can lead to conditions such as golfer's elbow or tennis elbow.
3. During the surgery, the surgeon carefully examined the integrity of the epicondyle for any signs of damage.
4. The epicondyle serves as a crucial point for ligaments that stabilize the elbow joint.
5. Anatomy students often study the epicondyle to understand the complexities of the arm's musculature.
