

EPIPLON

Meaning: Epiploon: a fold of peritoneum or a layer of fatty tissue that hangs from the colon and is involved in the abdominal cavity, often examined for inflammation.

1. The epiploic appendages are small pouches of fat that hang along the colon, often seen during surgeries.
2. Doctors sometimes examine the epiploic tissue for signs of inflammation during diagnostic procedures.
3. In advanced medical imaging, the epiploic area can reveal important information about abdominal health.
4. The epiploon's role in fat storage and immune response has been a topic of recent research.
5. Surgeons must be cautious when operating near the epiploic region to avoid complications.

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
