

EPISTROPHE

Meaning: Epistrophe is a rhetorical device involving the repetition of a word or phrase at the end of successive clauses or sentences for emphasis and effect.

1. The speaker's use of epistrophe emphasized the importance of her message by repeating the same phrase at the end of each statement.
2. In literature, epistrophe can create a rhythmic effect that enhances the emotional impact of the text.
3. Martin Luther King Jr. effectively employed epistrophe in his speeches to reinforce key ideas and inspire his audience.
4. The poet's strategic use of epistrophe added a memorable quality to the verses, making them resonate long after they were read.
5. By incorporating epistrophe into her writing, the author skillfully drew attention to the recurring themes of loss and hope.
