

EPITROCHLEAR

Meaning: Epitrochlear refers to the area or lymph nodes located near the epitrochlea, which is a bony prominence on the inner side of the elbow, often associated with lymphatic drainage in the upper extremities.

1. The epitrochlear lymph nodes are often examined during a physical assessment of the upper extremities.
2. Injuries to the epitrochlear region can result in significant pain and mobility issues for the patient.
3. Medical students were taught to recognize the importance of the epitrochlear nodes in diagnosing various infections.
4. The epitrochlear area can sometimes be a site of referred pain that complicates diagnostic procedures.
5. During the surgery, the surgeon carefully navigated around the epitrochlear structures to avoid damaging the nerves.
