

EQUIVOCACY

Meaning: Equivocacy refers to the quality of being deliberately ambiguous or having multiple meanings, often leading to confusion or uncertainty about one's true intentions.

1. The equivocacy in his statement left everyone confused about his true intentions.
2. During the debate, the equivocacy of her words allowed her to avoid taking a clear stance.
3. The politician was criticized for the equivocacy of his promises, which seemed vague and insincere.
