

# EQUIVOCATING

*Meaning: Equivocating refers to the act of being deliberately ambiguous or evasive in speech or writing, often to avoid committing to a clear position or truth.*

1. The politician was criticized for equivocating during the debate, failing to take a clear stance on key issues.
2. She was equivocating about her reasons for leaving, making it difficult for her friends to understand her true feelings.
3. Despite his attempts at equivocating, the truth of the situation became increasingly clear to everyone involved.
4. Her habit of equivocating when asked direct questions often led to misunderstandings and confusion among her colleagues.
5. The teacher noticed the student's equivocating responses and encouraged him to express his thoughts more openly.
