Meaning: Equivocatory: characterized by the use of ambiguous language to conceal the truth or avoid making a clear commitment.

1. The politician's equivocatory statements left voters confused about his true intentions.
2. In her equivocatory remarks, she skillfully avoided committing to any specific position.
3. The professor's equivocatory responses during the debate frustrated the students seeking clarity.
4. His equivocatory language made it difficult to discern whether he supported the initiative or not.
5. During the interview, her equivocatory answers raised more questions than they answered.
