Meaning: To remove or eliminate something, such as marks, writing, or mistakes, typically by rubbing or wiping it away.

1. She decided to erase the mistakes from her painting with a gentle stroke of her brush.
2. The teacher asked the student to erase any incorrect answers before submitting the test.
3. As soon as the computer crashed, he feared he would erase all his unsaved work.
4. To start fresh, she wanted to erase all memories of that difficult time in her life.
5. He used a special software to erase all traces of his online activity.
