Meaning: To burst forth suddenly and violently, as a volcano does, or to express strong feelings or emotions in an uncontrolled manner.

1. The volcano is expected to erupt after decades of dormancy.
2. Emotions can sometimes erupt unexpectedly during heated discussions.
3. A sudden storm caused the waves to erupt violently against the shore.
4. The debate over climate change has the potential to erupt into a major political issue.
5. When the news broke, cheers erupted from the crowd gathered outside.
