

ESOPHAGUS

Meaning: Esophagus: a muscular tube in the digestive system that connects the throat to the stomach, allowing the passage of food.

1. The esophagus is a muscular tube that connects the throat to the stomach.
2. When swallowing, food travels down the esophagus through a series of coordinated muscle contractions.
3. Esophageal cancer can develop in the lining of the esophagus, affecting its ability to function properly.
4. Gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD) occurs when stomach acid frequently flows back into the esophagus.
5. In certain medical procedures, doctors may insert a scope through the esophagus to examine the stomach.
