

ESTABLISHMENTARIAN

Meaning: Establishmentarian refers to a person or ideology that supports or upholds the existing social, political, or economic order, often favoring tradition and stability over progressive change.

1. The establishmentarian view often prioritizes tradition over progressive change.
2. Many critics argue that establishmentarian policies hinder social mobility and innovation.
3. In a debate about education reform, she identified herself as an establishmentarian, valuing stability over radical ideas.
4. The establishmentarian approach to governance tends to favor existing power structures and institutions.
