

ESTOP

Meaning: Estop: to prevent a party from asserting a claim or right due to their previous actions or conduct that would make such assertions unjust or contradictory.

1. The court ruled that the defendant was estopped from denying the agreement due to his previous actions.
2. In some cases, a party may be estopped from asserting a claim if it contradicts their earlier conduct.
3. The principle of estoppel prevents a person from going back on their word when others have relied on it.
4. Her consistent statements in the negotiations estopped her from later claiming ignorance of the terms.
5. The doctrine of estoppel serves to uphold fairness in contractual relationships by prohibiting contradictory positions.
