

ETHNARCHY

Meaning: Ethnarchy is a form of governance in which a leader, known as an ethnarch, governs a specific ethnic group within a larger political entity.

1. The concept of ethnarchy often emerges in discussions about the governance of diverse cultural groups within a single state.
2. In ancient times, some regions were ruled by ethnarchs who served as leaders for their specific ethnic communities.
3. Modern political theorists sometimes reference ethnarchy when analyzing the complexities of multicultural societies.
4. The ethnarchy established by the local chieftains allowed for a degree of autonomy while maintaining overall loyalty to the empire.
5. In the aftermath of conflict, the establishment of an ethnarchy could help stabilize relations among different ethnic groups.

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
