

ETHNOGRAPHY

Meaning: Ethnography is the systematic study and detailed description of the cultural practices, social structures, and behaviors of specific communities through direct observation and participation.

1. Ethnography allows researchers to gain deep insights into the cultural practices of different communities.
2. The ethnography conducted in the remote village revealed unique social structures that had been overlooked by mainstream studies.
3. She used ethnography as a method to explore the daily lives and rituals of the indigenous people.
4. In her dissertation, she emphasized the importance of participant observation in ethnography to capture authentic experiences.
