

ETIOLATION

Meaning: Etiolation refers to the condition of a plant or organism characterized by pale coloration and elongated growth due to insufficient light, or a lack of vitality and richness in perspective or experience.

1. The etiolations of the plants were evident in their pale, elongated stems reaching toward the light.
2. Her etiolated perspective on life made it difficult for her to appreciate the vibrant experiences around her.
3. The scientists observed the etiolations in the algae, which were caused by insufficient light exposure.
