

EUPHEMISM

Meaning: Euphemism is a mild or indirect word or expression used to replace one that may be considered harsh or blunt, particularly in sensitive contexts.

1. The term "passed away" is a common euphemism for dying.
2. Using a euphemism can soften the impact of difficult news.
3. In her speech, she employed a euphemism to address the sensitive topic.
4. The politician's euphemism for layoffs was "workforce realignment."
5. Euphemisms can often obscure the reality of a situation rather than clarify it.
