

EUPHEMIZE

Meaning: EUPHEMIZE: To replace a harsh or direct term with a milder or more vague expression to make it more acceptable or less unpleasant.

1. Many people tend to euphemize harsh realities to make them more palatable.
2. The politician chose to euphemize the layoffs by referring to them as "workforce adjustments."
3. In casual conversation, she would often euphemize her friend's lack of success as being "in a transitional phase."
4. To avoid sounding harsh, he decided to euphemize his criticism of the project as "room for improvement."
5. Teachers sometimes euphemize grades by stating that a student is "still developing" rather than failing.
