

# EXACERBATION

*Meaning: Exacerbation refers to the intensification or worsening of a condition, situation, or set of symptoms.*

1. The patient's condition worsened due to the exacerbation of their existing symptoms.
2. Her frustration only led to the exacerbation of the conflict between the two parties.
3. The exacerbation of the pollution levels raised concerns among environmentalists.
4. After several stressful weeks, his anxiety reached a point of exacerbation that required professional help.
