

EXACERRATING

Meaning: Exacerrating means making a situation worse or more intense, especially by increasing tension or frustration.

1. The politician's comments were exacerrating the already tense situation between the two communities.
2. Her constant complaints were exacerrating his frustration, making it difficult for him to concentrate.
3. He realized that his attempts to mediate were only exacerrating the conflict rather than resolving it.
4. The harsh criticism from the media seemed to be exacerrating the artist's anxiety about the upcoming performance.
5. In trying to explain his point, he inadvertently ended up exacerrating the misunderstandings among his colleagues.
