Meaning: Exaggeration is the act of representing something as greater or more intense than it actually is, often for emphasis or comedic effect.

1. Her tendency to speak in hyperbole often makes her stories feel like an exaggeration of reality.
2. The comedian's routine relied heavily on exaggeration, turning mundane experiences into comedic gold.
3. Despite his claims of climbing the highest peaks, many felt it was an exaggeration of his actual achievements.
