

EXAGGERATORY

Meaning: Exaggeratory refers to descriptions or claims that overstate or embellish the truth, often for dramatic or humorous effect.

1. Her exaggeratory claims about the product made it hard to trust the reviews.
2. The comedian's exaggeratory storytelling had everyone in stitches, even if some details were far-fetched.
3. In his exaggeratory fashion, he described his vacation as a journey through paradise, despite the rain.
4. While his enthusiasm was infectious, the exaggeratory nature of his anecdotes often led to skepticism.
5. Many found her exaggeratory remarks about her accomplishments to be more entertaining than credible.
