Meaning: Exagitate: to provoke or intensify a discussion or argument, often by exaggerating or inflating the significance of an issue.

1. The journalist's article seemed to exagitate the ongoing debate about climate change.

3. In an effort to exagitate the situation, she spoke in a tone that raised everyone's anxiety levels.
4. The politician's speech was designed to exagitate public sentiment against his opponent.
