Meaning: Execrate: to criticize or denounce someone or something with intense hatred or disdain.

1. To excoriate a person's character so harshly can often lead to unintended consequences.
2. The critics did not hesitate to execrate the film for its lack of originality.
3. In moments of anger, he tended to execrate those who disagreed with him.
4. Many in the community began to execrate the policies that they felt were unjust.
5. She could hardly contain her desire to execrate the betrayal she felt from her closest friend.
