

# EXCEDENT

*Meaning: Excedent refers to an amount that exceeds a limit or requirement, particularly a surplus or overflow, such as excess flow in a river or surplus in financial accounts.*

2. In accounting, an excedent represents the surplus after all expenses have been deducted.
