Meaning: Exception: a case or instance that does not conform to a general rule or standard.

1. The teacher made an exception for the student who had a valid excuse for missing class.
2. In most cases, the rules are strictly enforced, but there are exceptions for unique situations.
3. She is an exception to the common stereotype, excelling in both science and literature.
4. Despite the team's poor performance, the coach believed there was an exception among the players.
5. This policy allows for exceptions in cases of extreme hardship or unforeseen circumstances.
