

EXCEPTIVE

Meaning: Exceptive (adjective): relating to or denoting a clause or statement that specifies exceptions or exclusions from a general rule or provision.

1. The exceptive clause in the contract clearly outlined conditions that were not applicable.
2. In legal discussions, the exceptive nature of a statement can significantly alter its interpretation.
3. She was the exceptive case in an otherwise uniform group, demonstrating extraordinary talent.
4. The teacher noted the exceptive rules that applied to the students who had special needs.
5. He made an exceptive remark, indicating that everyone was welcome to join except for those who were disruptive.
