Meaning: Exclusionary refers to practices or policies that deliberately restrict or prevent certain individuals or groups from participating or being included.

1. The club's exclusionary policies prevented many potential members from joining.
2. Her remarks during the meeting were viewed as exclusionary, alienating several colleagues.
3. The exclusionary nature of the event sparked a debate about inclusivity in the community.
4. Many critics argue that exclusionary practices in education limit opportunities for underprivileged students.
5. The company's exclusionary hiring process resulted in a lack of diversity in the workplace.
