

EXCOMMUNE

Meaning: Excommunicate: to officially exclude an individual from participation in the sacraments and services of a church, often as a punishment for violating its doctrines.

1. The church decided to excommunicate the member after repeated violations of its doctrines.
2. In medieval times, to excommunicate someone was often seen as a powerful tool to enforce moral behavior within a community.
3. When the leader was excommunicated, many followers were confused about their allegiance to the faith.
4. The decision to excommunicate her was met with backlash from the congregation, who viewed it as unjust.
5. Excommunication can have severe social repercussions, isolating individuals from their community and support systems.
