

EXCOMMUNICANT

Meaning: Excommunicant: a person who has been officially excluded from participation in the sacraments and services of a religious community, typically due to violating its laws or doctrines.

1. The excommunicant was shunned by the community for violating the church's sacred laws.
2. After his excommunication, he struggled to find a sense of belonging outside the confines of his former faith.
3. The council debated the consequences of labeling someone as an excommunicant in such a close-knit congregation.
4. Despite being an excommunicant, she still attended the services in hopes of reconciliation.
5. His status as an excommunicant weighed heavily on him, making it difficult to connect with friends and family.
