

# EXCOMMUNION

*Meaning: Excommunication is the formal exclusion of a person from participation in the sacraments and services of a Christian church, often due to heretical beliefs or actions.*

1. The priest announced the excommunication of the member for heretical beliefs.
2. After a long deliberation, the church council decided on the harsh measure of excommunication.
3. Excommunication is often seen as a last resort for maintaining the integrity of a religious community.
4. The concept of excommunication has evolved over the centuries, reflecting changes in church doctrine.
