

EXCUSATORY

Meaning: Excusatory refers to something that serves to excuse or justify an action or behavior, often to lessen blame or responsibility.

1. The lawyer presented an excusatory argument to mitigate his client's culpability.
2. She offered an excusatory explanation for her tardiness, citing unexpected traffic.
3. His excusatory tone suggested he was trying to shift the blame onto external factors.
4. The teacher found his excusatory remarks unconvincing and emphasized the importance of accountability.
5. In her excusatory letter, she detailed the circumstances that led to her absence from the meeting.
