

EXEMPTION

Meaning: Exemption refers to the official release or relief from an obligation or requirement, such as taxes or testing.

1. The organization applied for tax exemption to support its charitable activities.
2. Students with disabilities may qualify for an exemption from certain testing requirements.
3. After reviewing her case, the committee granted her an exemption from the mandatory course.
4. The new policy included an exemption for small businesses to ease their financial burden.
5. He was thrilled to learn that his income level made him eligible for a student loan exemption.
