

EXEQUATUR

Meaning: Exequatur is a legal authorization granted by a court to recognize and enforce a foreign arbitration award or judgment.

1. The court issued an exequatur to recognize the foreign arbitration award.
2. Obtaining an exequatur can be a lengthy process depending on the jurisdiction.
3. After the exequatur was granted, the ruling could be enforced locally without further challenge.
4. Diplomatic missions often assist citizens in obtaining an exequatur for legal documents.
5. The exequatur process ensures that international agreements are upheld within domestic law.
