

EXPOSTULATE

Meaning: To expostulate means to express strong disapproval or to reason earnestly with someone about their actions or decisions.

1. She attempted to expostulate with him about the dangers of his reckless behavior.
2. Despite her efforts to expostulate, he remained resolute in his decision to leave.
3. The teacher tried to expostulate with the students about the importance of studying for the exam.
4. Friends often expostulate with one another to express their concerns and opinions.
5. He felt it was his duty to expostulate against the proposed changes to the policy.
6. She tried to expostulate with her friend about the poor decision he was making.
7. The teacher expostulated with the students, urging them to reconsider their choices.
8. After the meeting, he felt compelled to expostulate against the proposed changes to the policy.
