Meaning: Expostulatory: expressing strong disapproval or reasoning against something, often in a persuasive manner.

1. The teacher's expostulatory tone made it clear that she disapproved of the students' behavior.
2. In his expostulatory letter, he urged the committee to reconsider their decision.
3. Her expostulatory remarks during the meeting highlighted the need for better communication.
