Meaning: Exprobrate: to criticize or reprimand someone for their shortcomings or failures.

1. The teacher did not hesitate to exprobrate the student's lack of effort in completing the assignment.
2. During the meeting, the manager exprobrated the team for missing the deadline despite repeated reminders.
3. In her speech, she exprobrated the injustices faced by marginalized communities, calling for immediate action.
4. His decision to exprobrate the policies of the administration drew both praise and criticism from his peers.
5. The critic exprobrated the film for its lack of originality and depth, leaving little room for debate.
