

EXPROPRIATE

Meaning: Expropriate: to take possession of private property by a government or authority for public use, typically with compensation to the owner.

1. The government has the authority to expropriate private land for public use, provided that fair compensation is given.
2. Historically, many countries have resorted to expropriating foreign assets during times of political upheaval.
3. The local council decided to expropriate the abandoned property to build a new community center.
4. He challenged the legality of the state's decision to expropriate his family's farm without adequate notice.
5. Activists argue that the expropriation of natural resources often disregards the rights of indigenous populations.
