Meaning: Expurgation is the process of removing or censoring objectionable or inappropriate content from a text or material.

1. The expurgation of controversial content from literary texts has sparked debates among scholars and educators.

3. The committee's expurgation of the report left out critical information that could have informed the public.
4. In the process of expurgation, the editor aimed to preserve the author's original intent while removing offensive language.
