Meaning: Expurge: to remove or eliminate something undesirable or outdated, especially in order to improve clarity or efficiency.

2. In an effort to improve transparency, the organization aimed to expurge any misleading information from its reports.
3. She felt it was necessary to expurge negative influences from her life to achieve her goals.
4. The editor worked diligently to expurge irrelevant details from the manuscript before publication.
5. To maintain the integrity of the study, researchers had to expurge any biased data collected during the trial.
