Meaning: Exscribe: to write or inscribe notes or thoughts in the margins or on the edges of a page or document.

1. The artist decided to exscribe her thoughts into the margins of her sketchbook.
2. As a historian, he aimed to exscribe the forgotten tales of his community into a new publication.
3. To preserve the ancient manuscript, they chose to exscribe its contents onto a digital format.
4. The poet would exscribe her feelings onto the pages, transforming her emotions into art.
5. In a rare moment of clarity, he began to exscribe the lessons learned from his experiences.
