

EXSECT

Meaning: Exsect (verb): to remove or cut out a section of tissue or an organ, typically during a surgical procedure.

1. The surgeon decided to exsect the tumor to prevent further complications.
2. During the procedure, the doctor had to exsect a portion of the affected tissue.
3. In advanced cases, it may be necessary to exsect the damaged organ entirely.
