Meaning: Exsiccate: to remove moisture from a substance, typically to preserve or prepare it for analysis or conservation.

1. The laboratory technician needed to exsiccate the samples before conducting the chemical analysis.
2. To preserve the ancient manuscripts, conservators must exsiccate the paper fibers carefully.
3. Exsiccating the herbs enhances their flavor and potency for culinary use.
4. The process of exsiccating the fruit removes moisture, allowing it to be stored for longer periods.
5. Researchers often exsiccated the plant specimens to study their morphological characteristics in detail.
