

EXSICCATOR

Meaning: Exsiccator: a laboratory apparatus used to remove moisture from samples by creating a low-humidity environment.

1. An exsiccator is commonly used in laboratories to remove moisture from samples.
2. In the absence of an exsiccator, we risk compromising the integrity of our hygroscopic materials.
3. The technician carefully placed the glass vials into the exsiccator to ensure they remained dry.
4. Using an exsiccator can significantly improve the accuracy of weight measurements in experiments.
5. After the reaction, the solid product was transferred to the exsiccator for further drying.
