

EXSUDATION

Meaning: Exsudation is the process of the release or discharge of fluids, such as from a wound or by plants, often indicating physiological responses or conditions.

1. The exsudation of fluids from the wound indicated a possible infection.
2. In botany, exsudation refers to the process by which plants release excess water and nutrients.
3. The scientist studied the exsudation of certain minerals from the soil during heavy rainfall.
4. During the experiment, the exsudation of gases from the chemical reaction was carefully monitored.
5. Exsudation can significantly affect the health of soil ecosystems by altering moisture levels.
