

EXTENUATOR

Meaning: Extenuator: a factor or circumstance that mitigates or reduces the severity of an offense or situation.

1. The lawyer presented a compelling extenuator that highlighted her client's difficult upbringing.

3. The judge considered the extenuator of mental health issues before handing down the sentence.
