Meaning: Externalistic: relating to or denoting a perspective that emphasizes the influence of external factors, such as context or environment, on understanding and meaning.

1. The philosopher's argument took an externalistic approach, emphasizing the role of context in understanding meaning.
2. In cognitive science, externalistic theories suggest that our mental states are influenced by our interactions with the environment.
3. The debate between internalism and externalism in epistemology often hinges on whether knowledge is inherently personal or externalistic.
4. Critics of externalistic perspectives argue that they neglect the importance of individual cognition and internal processes.
5. Her research focuses on externalistic factors that shape social behavior, particularly in multicultural settings.
