

# EXTRADITABLE

*Meaning: Extraditable refers to a person's eligibility to be surrendered by one jurisdiction to another for prosecution or punishment under applicable legal agreements.*

1. The suspect was found to be extraditable under the terms of the treaty.
2. Legal experts debated whether the charges were serious enough to warrant extraditable status.
3. In this case, the defendant's actions were deemed extraditable by the court.
4. The country has strict regulations regarding which crimes are considered extraditable.
