

EXTRADITE

Meaning: To extradite means to legally transfer a person accused or convicted of a crime from one jurisdiction to another for prosecution or to serve a sentence.

1. The government is working with international authorities to extradite the suspect.
2. After a lengthy legal battle, they managed to extradite the criminal to face charges in his home country.
3. The treaty allows both nations to extradite fugitives without lengthy negotiations.
4. She was relieved to hear that they would finally extradite her ex-partner for trial.
5. The court ruled that the evidence was sufficient to support the request to extradite him.
