

# EXTRAVASATE

*Meaning: Extravasate: to escape from a vessel (such as a blood vessel) into surrounding tissues, often causing damage or adverse effects.*

1. The technician warned that if the fluid were to extravasate, it could cause significant tissue damage.
2. During the procedure, the doctor was careful to monitor for signs that the medication might extravasate into the surrounding tissues.
