

EXTORSE

Meaning: Extrorse describes floral parts that are oriented outward, away from the center of the flower.

1. The extrorse petals of the flower opened wide, revealing their vibrant colors.
2. In botany, extrorse refers to the orientation of floral parts that face outward rather than inward.
3. The extrorse nature of the plant's anthers allowed for efficient pollen dispersal by the wind.
